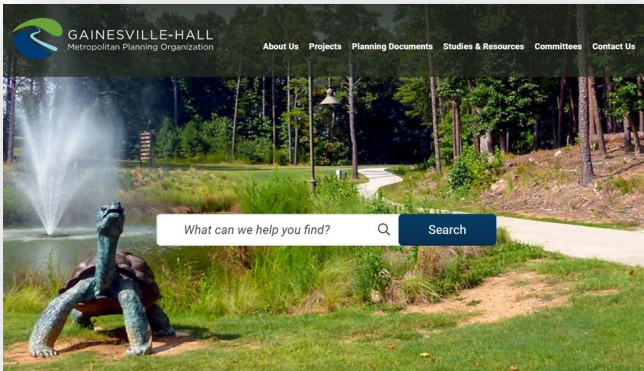

Regional Transportation Plan: 2020 Update

- First draft of RTP document will be reviewed at February/March MPO Committee Meetings
- RTP final adoption scheduled for April/May MPO Committee Meetings

SR 365 / Jesse Jewell Pkwy Traffic Study

- Currently reviewing data collected along corridor, existing conditions, freight patterns, expected growth patterns, & developing stakeholder lists
- Study is scheduled for completion by June 2020

Jackson County Transit Study

- Transit Feasibility Study for Jackson County exploring all potential transit options to best serve the community needs
- Study kicked off in October 2019, expected to be concluded by June 2020
