1. Welcome

Mayor Nix called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

2. Approval of February 23, 2012 Meeting Minutes

<u>MOTION</u>: Mr. Petrie made a motion to approve the February 23, 2012 Minutes with a second by Mr. Hopkins and the motion passed by a unanimous vote.

3. Recommendation to Approve the Draft FY 2013 Unified Planning Work Program

Mr. Yamala stated the document is nearly the same as the one they reviewed in February. The only change made was to the Funding Summary to update the local in-kind match totals.

MOTION: Mr. Cochran made a motion to recommend approval of the Draft FY2013 UPWP with a second by Ms. Lipscomb and the motion passed by a unanimous vote.

4. I-985 Park-n-Ride Lots (Exit 4, Exit 16, Exit 17) Survey Results

Mr. Fee explained objective of the surveys was to assess the level of demand for express bus service towards Atlanta from the park and ride lots, and to determine commuting patterns and usage of the lots. Mr. Fee's expressed his opinions on why the Exit 17 lot was underutilized. The split diamond interchange configuration for Exits 16 and 17 may inhibit access from both directions of travel along I-985 and not turning on the lot lights discourages commuters worried about safety issues.

5. Transportation Investment Act: Discussion of Local Projects

Mr. Yamala had hoped he would be able to present a list of proposed local projects the that would use local discretionary funds from the TIA, if the referendum passes. He explained that the Hall County Engineering staff has not been able to present a list of proposed projects to the Board of Commissioners yet.

6. Jurisdiction and Agency Reports

Mr. Fee discussed the status of transportation projects being completed by the following jurisdictions: City of Gainesville, City of Oakwood and Hall County.
