1. Welcome

Mr. McInturff called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

2. Approval of July 14, 2010, Meeting Minutes

MOTION: *Mr. Yamala made a motion to recommend approval of the July 14, 2010, Minutes with a second by Mr. Woodall and the motion passed by a unanimous vote.*

3. 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan – Status Update

Mr. Yamala informed the committee they are actively working on the 2040 MTP along with the consultant team. Adoption date of this plan is August 2011 and they hope to send a draft of the plan out in early March for review by the committees.

Mr. Carroll stated that the population and employment forecasts had been reviewed and approved. He said GDOT was working with him on the travel demand modeling (TDM) and they should have the base year data with projects completed or under construction in the model by the next meeting. Mr. Carroll noted they had a good turnout with 34 attendees signing in for the July 14th first public meeting and received several comments and recommendations. There will be three more public meetings between now and August to

present the goals and objectives, discuss the types of improvements and present the draft plan.

4. Recommendation to approve Draft GHMPO Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan

Mr. Yamala gave a brief overview of the Draft GHMPO Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan that was presented to the TCC for their review in July.

MOTION: Mr. Woodall made a motion to recommend approval of the Draft GHMPO Limited English Proficiency Plan with a second by Mr. Riker and the motion passed by a unanimous vote.

5. Jurisdiction and Agency Reports

Representatives discussed the status of transportation projects being completed by their jurisdictions: Mr. Riker for the City of Flowery Branch, Mr. Ligon for the City of Gainesville, Mr. Brown for the City of Oakwood, Mr. Heath for GDOT, Ms. Harmon for GMRC, and Mr. Woodall for Hall County.

6. Upcoming Meeting Date

The next TCC meeting is scheduled for February 16, 2011.

7. Other

A schedule of 2011 GHMPO Committee Meetings was handed out.

Mr. Yamala presented a TIP amendment on the Sardis Road Connector which would change the right-of-way (ROW) to 2012 and increase funding in ROW and preliminary engineering (PE) phases. Hall County will devote over \$37 million more in SPLOST funds for ROW acquisition and \$1.3 million for PE.


MOTION: Mr. Yamala made a motion to recommend approval of the GHMPO 2008-2013 TIP Amendment with a second by Mr. Woodall and the motion passed by a unanimous vote.
